Hanging out in St Andrews

The College Links Invitational includes lots of great golf but we have also made room for some down time so that groups can experience the charm of St Andrews itself.

This bustling university town is an enjoyable place to spend a bit of time between rounds. There are plenty of coffee shops and boutique stores to browse on the main streets and some terrific ways to while away a few hours. Here are a few of our favourites:

Hit the heights

Overlooking Castle Sands, the historic St Andrews Cathedral ruins are a sight to behold. Entrance to the ruins and the graveyard is free but it's worth shelling out a few pounds for a ticket to the Cathedral Museum, which includes entry to St Rule's Tower – the view from the top is unbeatable.

Beach bliss

The West Sands – immortalised in the opening scene of the Oscar-winning film 'Chariots of Fire' – form a picturesque backdrop to the opening and closing holes of the Old Course. Queue up your music device to the movie's iconic score and make your way along the edge of the rolling surf as the sunset reflects on the water. Perfection!

Sweet treats

A St Andrews institution, Jannettas Gelateria has been satisfying the town's sweet tooth for more than 100 years and is consistently ranked among the best ice-cream stores in Scotland. College Links Golf recommends Orange & Mascarpone in a waffle cone, but with more than 100 flavours on offer, it's impossible to go wrong!

Follow the saints

St Salvatore's Chapel, founded in 1450, has a storied history. Today this stunning gothic building is the main place of worship for St Andrews University and also hosts the St Salvatore's Chapel Choir

Spine-chilling thrills

The St Andrews Ghost Tour is an eerie adventure through the town's old quarter. The tour is based on the book, 'Ghosts of St Andrews' by Richard Falconer and is great, ghoulish fun.

Watch the golfers come home

One of the Old Course's greatest charms is its closing hole – the 18th green is nestled in the very heart of the town. Leaning on the distinctive white fence which borders the property and watching golfers finish their round on this famous stretch of golfing property is a strangely captivating experience.

The Old Course ballot

Tee bookings at the Old Course are ludicrously over-subscribed and each slot could be filled a dozen times over during the busy summer months.

As part of its commitment to make the Old Course accessible to as many people as possible, the St Andrews Links Trust still upholds the tradition of a daily ballot, or lottery, which enables golfers who are in the area to have a chance of playing the legendary links during their stay.

Entering the ballot remains an excellent way of getting an Old Course tee-time – around 35 per cent of rounds are allocated in this way. You'll find out if your application has been successful two days before your allotted tee time.

If you'd like to enter the ballot, College Links Golf will arrange for your name to be entered into the daily draw. Just provide us with a copy of your handicap certificate and we'll do the rest!

Even if your ballot application is unsuccessful, there are still opportunities to secure a round on the Old Course. Slots for single or pairs of golfers can become available at short notice due to cancellations. College Links Golf will keep in touch with the Old Course starter to ascertain whether any slots are likely to arise over the course of the day.

Advance bookings

Each year there is an opportunity for visiting golfers to apply in advance for Old Course tee times. These places are strictly limited and the window for applications only lasts three weeks.

The details for the 2020 advance booking process have yet to be confirmed but the booking window is likely to take place in August/September 2019, with successful applicants receiving notification in October 2019.

Limited companies (like College Links Golf) are not permitted to make an application on your behalf but we can guide you through the process.
